Executive Committee Teleconference Meeting
March 6, 2008

President Erwin called the meeting to order at 6:38pm.

Those present in the teleconference were: Kevin Erwin, Walt Hastings, David Ver Halen, Ray Brassler, Dan Hoffman, Jim McCullough, Fred Piazza, Bob Slough, and Jessica Anderson.

President Erwin opened the discussion with a brief recap of the issue discussed at the February 9th Board meeting about some squads shooting late/early at our state shoot and the possibility of putting language in our state shoot program similar to what PITA uses in their programs; i.e. "If you are assigned an early squad for the first event you enter, you must be assigned an early squad for all remaining events".

Discussion ensued about 1) there being ATA trophies involved and we couldn't impose non-ATA rules on ATA trophies, 2) language that could be used to restrict CGSTA trophies, 3) there being no restrictions on shooting late/early at the Grand or satellite grands, or other state shoots that we're aware of, 4) the option of shooting late/early at our state shoot was open to any shooter who wanted to do it, and 5) the new Pat Traps had gone a long ways towards leveling the playing field.

This resulted in the following:

To not add any language to our state shoot program about shooting late/early and to leave the state shoot program as it is.

Passed: Yes – 7, No – 1, President Abstained.
