This program has been carefully prepared and the events scheduled and planned in accordance with conditions and expected attendance. However, the management reserves the right to alter this program if conditions warrant at the time of the shoot.

Scorers will call out scores after five targets. It is your responsibility to correct any errors at that time. The score sheets will not be changed after a round of five targets has been shot.

There will be no ties. Ties can be called on a coin flip or if requested a shoot-off will be scheduled. Any required shootoff will take place at the end of all scheduled events for the day. When a shoot-off is called, absent contestant(s) forfeits.

Any shooter winning or tying 16-yard or Doubles event will advance one (1) class next event.

No shooter may win more than one award in any one event. Ladies, Juniors, and Veterans may win only one award per event or combined events.

All dogs and animals must be on a leash while on the club grounds. Under no circumstance are animals permitted inside the clubhouse. Please clean up after your pets.

The club will not tolerate verbal abuse of trap club help. If you have a problem, please notify club management.
