**VETERAN TEAM:** Top 2 Veteran shooters, Top 2 Sr. Vet shooters, and the next highest Vet./Sr. Vet score.

All shooters must declare at time of entry which team they are trying to obtain. Any shooter not declaring a category at time of entry shall be placed in category according to age.

#### Classification

1. Shooters not having shot registered 1000 Singles targets in the current and previous two (2) target years combined will shoot class A or higher at the discretion of the Handicap Committee.
2. Shooters not having shot 1000 registered Handicap targets in the current and previous two (2) target years combined will shoot penalty yardage. Adult Men, JR Gold Men, and Junior Men will shoot no less than 24 yards. Women (including Lady I, Lady II, and Junior Gold Ladies), Sub-Juniors, Veterans, and SR. Veteran will shoot no less than 23 yards.
3. Shooters not having shot registered 500 Doubles targets in the current and previous two (2) target years combined will shoot class A or higher at the discretion of the Handicap Committee.

# General Information

- ATA rules will govern this shoot and all targets will be registered with the ATA.
- Your score is your responsibility. The scorekeepers will call out the scores after each 5 targets. It is your responsibility to correct any scores at that time. The score sheets will not be changed after shooting the first target on your next post or in the case of the last post, before you leave the field.
- Wins or ties for singles and doubles move up 1 class the next event for the remainder of the shoot.
- Three (3) or more shooters required in each class for trophies and added money including High Lady, High Junior, High Vet for each event.
- The management reserves the right to change, modify, postpone or cancel any event due to bad weather, darkness or other causes at their discretion.
- Only shoot management may reset targets. Shooters may request targets be evaluated for legality only to shoot management.
- A shooter opting to pull out after an event has started will not be refunded purse and option money if the scores are posted.
- Any vendors caught selling ammo on the grounds will immediately be asked to leave.
- Options may be played until the first scores are posted.
- Management is not responsible for any typographical errors in the program. Changes will be posted if necessary.
- Ammunition restrictions can be found in the ATA rulebook. All shooters are required to have a digital waiver on file. You can find the waiver at [www.redlandsshootingpark.com](http://www.redlandsshootingpark.com) or in the clubhouse at the range.
