SHOOT RULES

**SILVER DOLLAR BUCKLE
TO HIGH HANDICAP CHAMPION IN
EITHER of EVENTS 2, 4, or 5.**

This buckle will be awarded
to the shooter with the highest score of
either handicap events 2, 4, or 5.
ONLY ONE buckle will be awarded.
Shooters will have three chances to shoot
the highest score of the three events.
(Ties shoot off)

ATA rules will govern this shoot and all targets will be
registered with the ATA.

TIES for awards will be shot off the day the event is
finished, time permitting. Any shooter who is called
for a shoot-off and is absent forfeits his/her rights
therein.

SCORER will call out scores after five targets. It is your
responsibility to correct any errors at that time. The
score sheets will not be changed after a round of five
targets has been shot.

NO shooter may win more than one award in any
one event. Ladies, Juniors and Vets may win only
one award per event or combined event.

PERFECT 50's payout will be 75% of total. 25% to
remain in the pot for the following event. Perfect 50's
purses start at... #1=\$485, purse #2=\$443.75 and purse
#3=258.83.

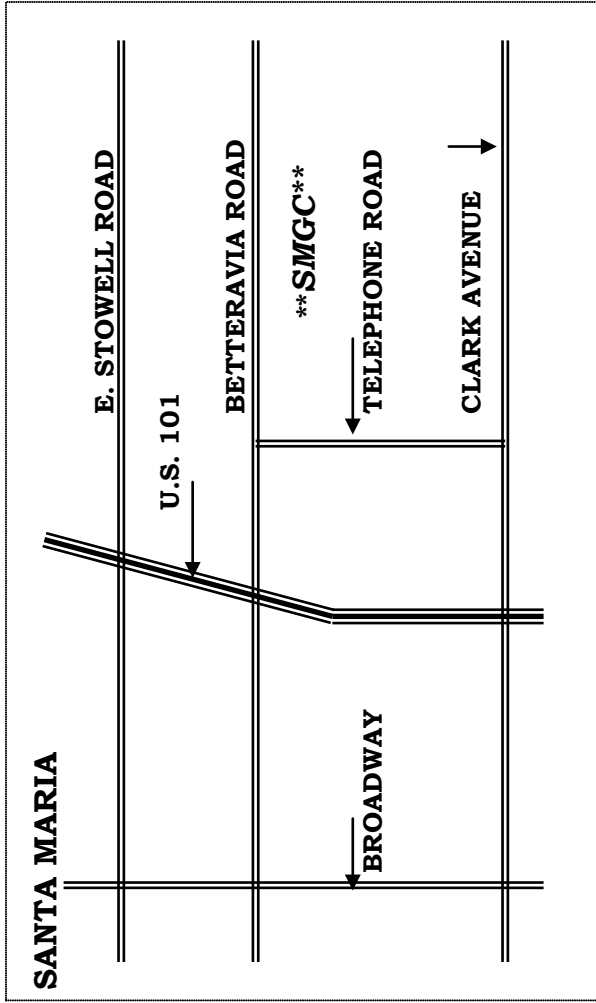
