- Directions follow:
 - If you come from the south of Santa Barbara, take 101 North to the Hwy 154 Cachuma Lake off ramp. The road is 2 lanes, so take your time! The lake entrance is approximately 18 miles from 101 on the right-hand side of the road and the entrance to the Club is a mile from the lake entrance on the left side of the road. There are no signs to the club, but there is a center turn lane and a big silver gate at the entrance to the Club that you will have to go through. The entrance is directly across from call box I54-137. If the gate is closed, please make sure you close it after you go through the gate, we are on private property and there could be cattle in the area.
 - If you come from the north take 101 South to the 154 off ramp. The road is 2 lanes, so take your time! The entrance to the club is approximately 6 miles past the Round-About intersection of 154 and 246. The club is on the right-hand side of the road. There will be a sign that says "Bradbury Dam" right at the entrance to the club. If you miss the entrance to the club, the lake's entrance is just a mile; you can turn around there. There is a big silver gate at the entrance to the Club. If the gate is closed, please make sure you close it after you go through the gate, we are on private property and there could be cattle in the area
